- Perform daily inspection of truck tires, lights, brakes, fluids, etc. to ensure safe and costeffective performance with preventive maintenance in mind
- Deliver orders via the most effective route assigned by APS to ensure complete orders are delivered according to established time frames and customers' needs
- Maintain communication with Supervisor during deliveries
- Document delivery, accuracy and receipt of orders by the customer according to company directives and report any discrepancies to company
- Increase customer satisfaction by collecting information, feedback on service and resolving complaints per company policy; communicate information back to your supervisor
- Maintain and monitor truck maintenance and driving record requirements, and maintain required documents for safety, security and quality processes
- Safely operate forklifts and other warehouse equipment as required
